Wood packing material

This is to notify that the enforcement date previously notified under document G/SPS/N/JAM/13 dated 10 August 2010 is being adjusted to a new enforcement date of 1 March 2011. This is being done after numerous communication from both National and International stakeholders regarding lack of circulation of this information in their respective countries hence the lack of previous knowledge of the full implementation of ISPM 15 in Jamaica.
